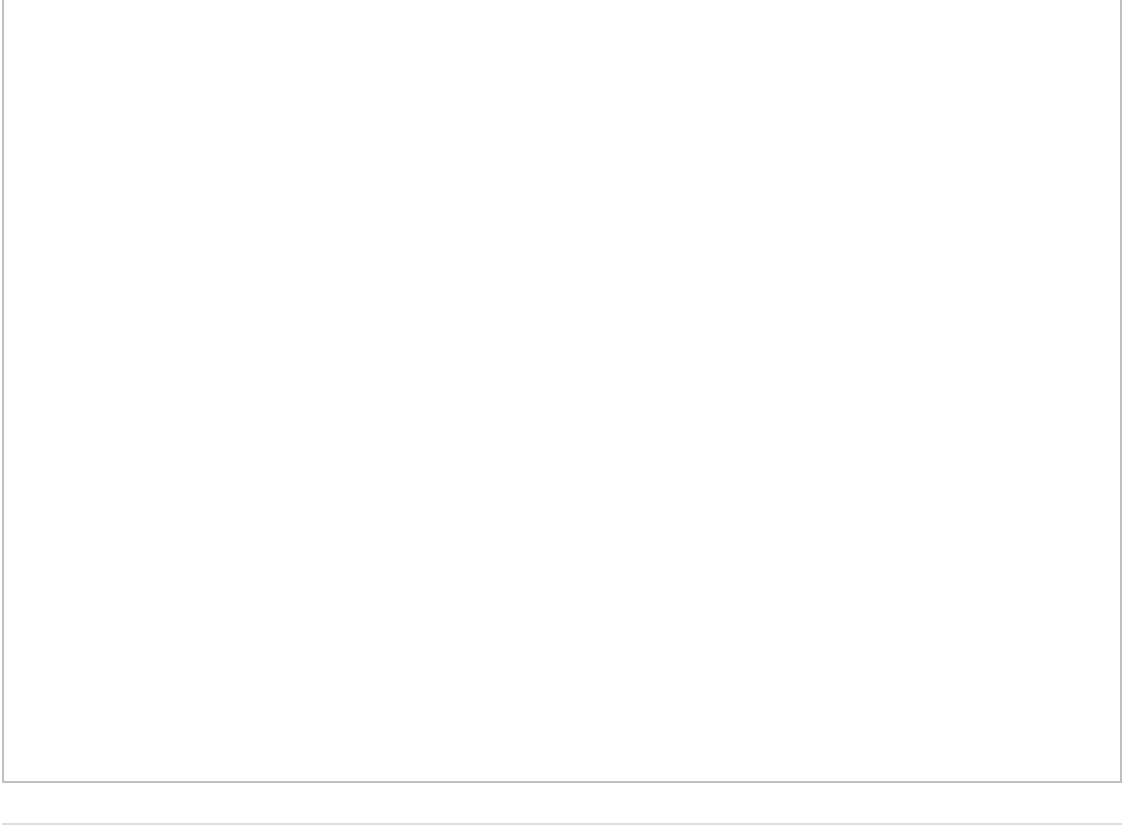

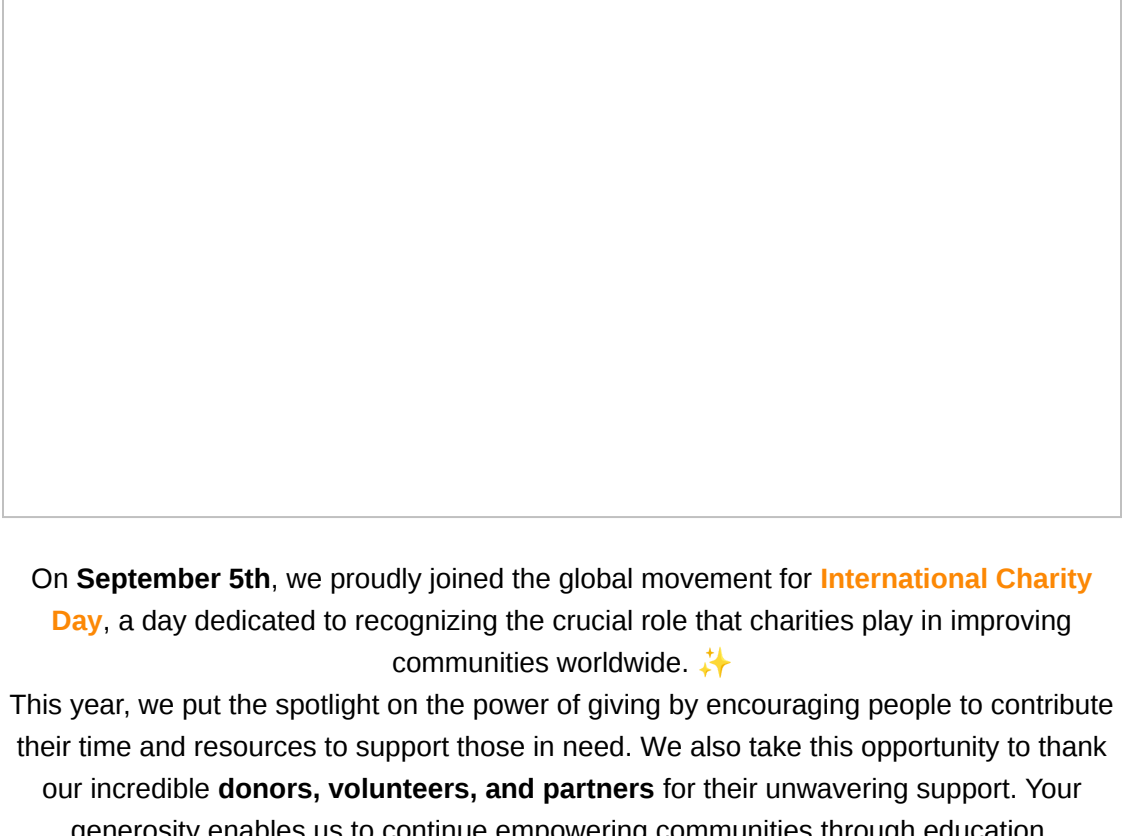
Back to School: A Fresh Start for Students

- Location: Reside in Lagos or able to travel to Lagos

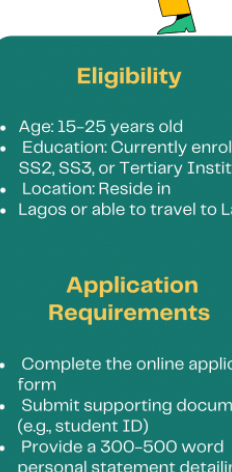

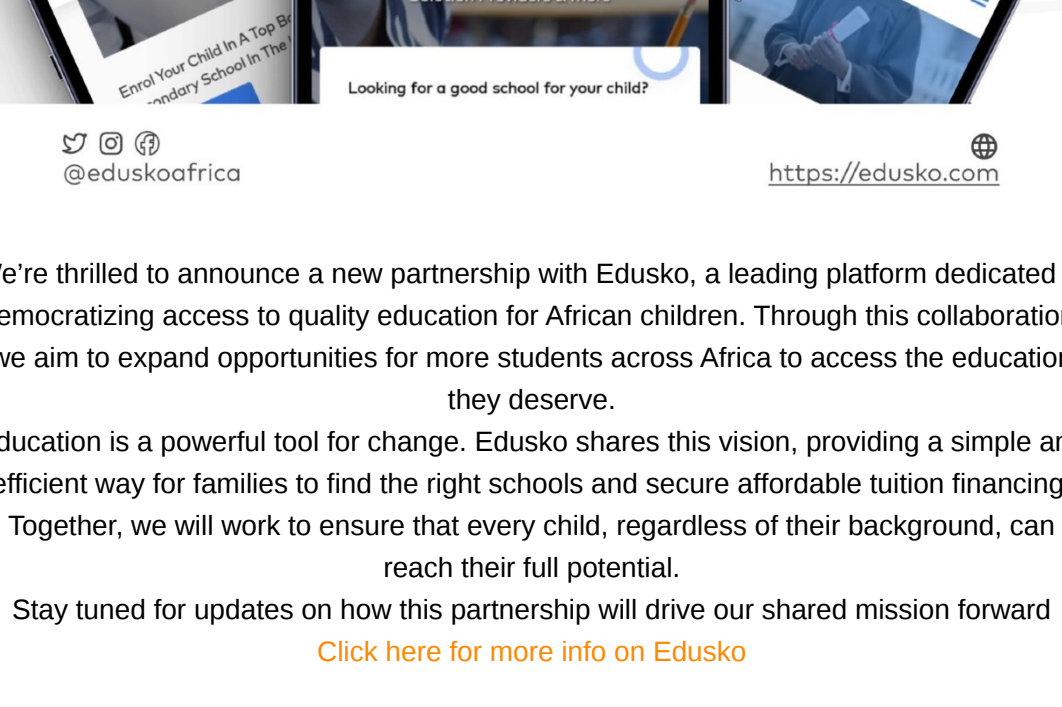
