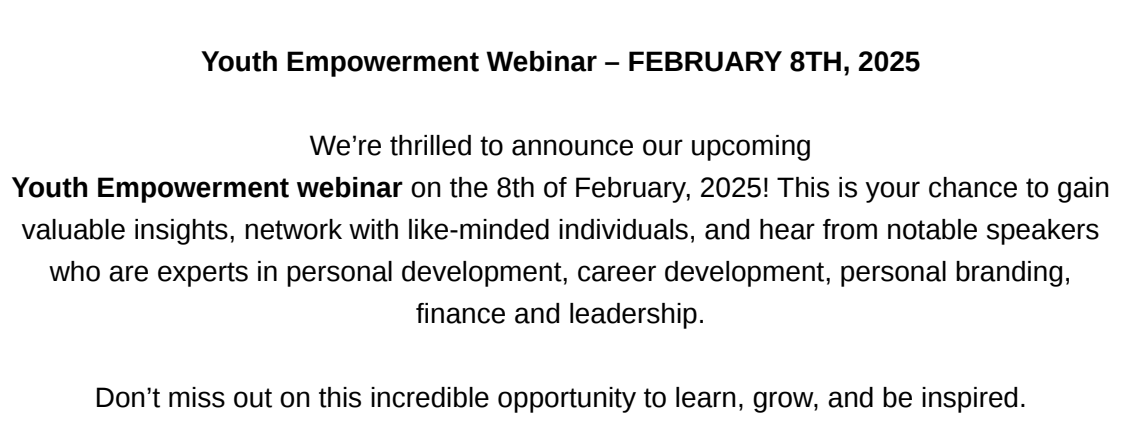
- Education:** Providing access to quality education for underserved communities.

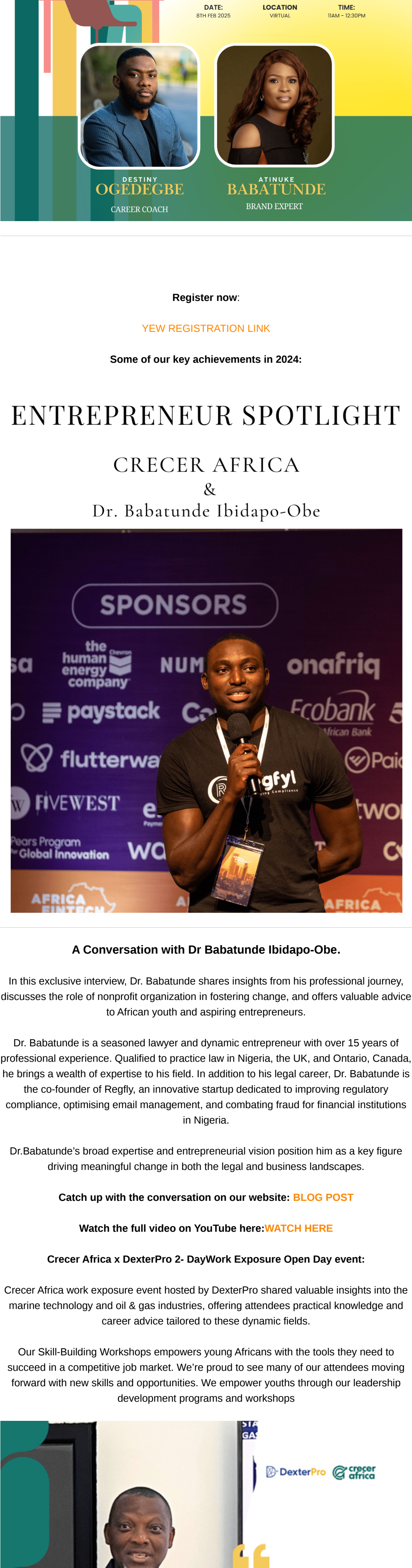

Dr.Babatunde's broad expertise and entrepreneurial vision position him as a key figure driving meaningful change in both the legal and business landscapes.

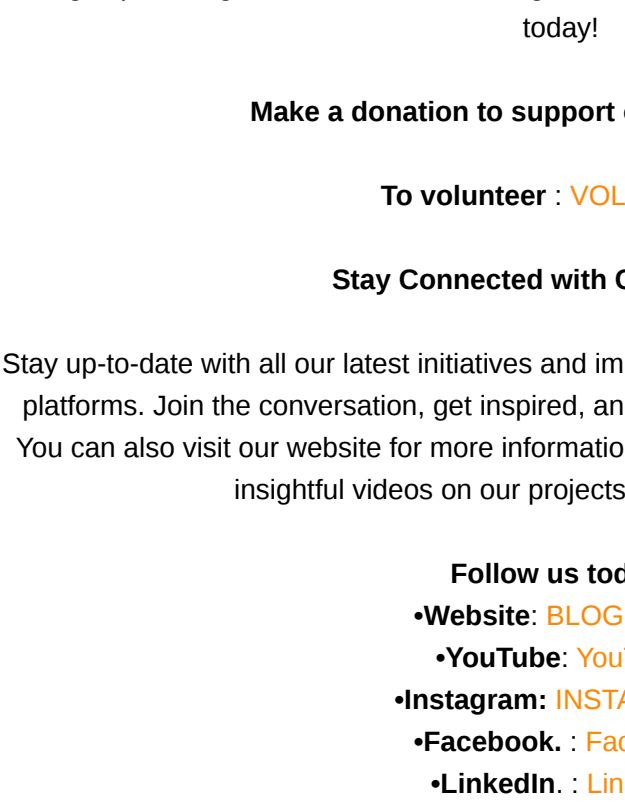

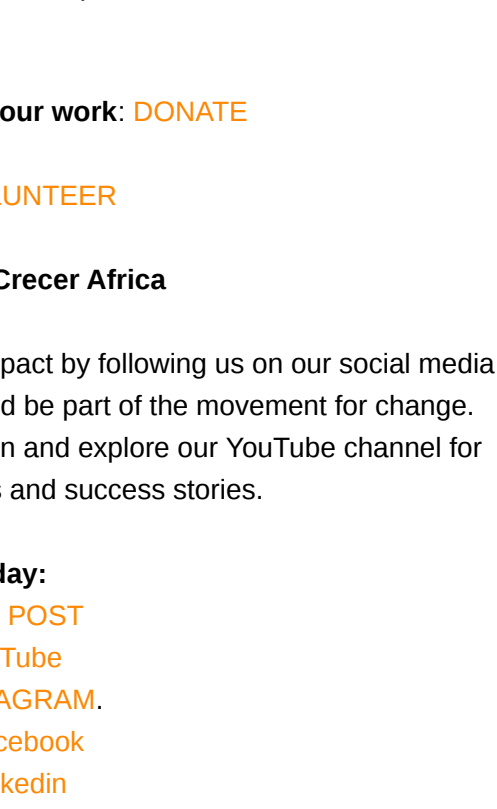
